#### **Aero Modelling Competition 2010**

Following discussions with the judges this year and representations from wings it has been decided to announce the 2010 models straight away. The models will all be 1/72 scale and will be from the World War Two era, as 2010 marks the 70th anniversary of the Battle of Britain. The judges consider the quality of the modelling, not the actual model.

Group A - 13-14 years on 30 Apr 2010 - Any 1/72 scale single engine WW2 era military aircraft

Group B - 15 - 16 years on 30 Apr 2010 - Any 1/72 scale twin engines WW2 era military aircraft

Group C - 17 years and over on 30 Apr 2010 - Any 1/72 scale four engine WW2 era military aircraft

All models are to be free standing, with the undercarriage down and not mounted in any way. Additional information such as photographs may NOT be included with the entry. Details will need to be provided of the modeller, Rank, Full Name, Sqn and Wing for prize and certificate reasons.

There is no requirement for Wings to be as free with their model choices for their own competitions and may choose to be more prescriptive if they wish. However, all wings are to provide three models for the 2010 competition in accordance with the above criteria.
